The Management of the Next REF

Background

Overall responsibility for the University's next REF submission rests with the PVC(R), who in practice delegates most day-to-day activities to the REF Manager.

The organisational structure responsible for oversight and management of the development and submission of the next REF includes a REF Policy Committee and a REF Project Board.

REF Policy Committee

The REF Policy Committee's primary role is to set key REF policies, taking into consideration advice from the REF Project Board. It reports to RPC. Its membership comprises:

REF Project Board

The REF Project Board is responsible for operational REF matters. It oversees progress in the preparation and development of the University's submission, and identifies issues requiring action and ensures that such actions are taken. It reports to the REF Policy Committee. Its membership comprises:
